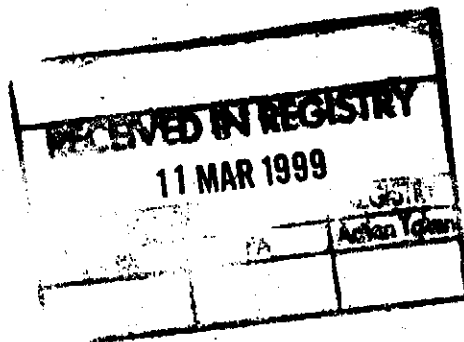

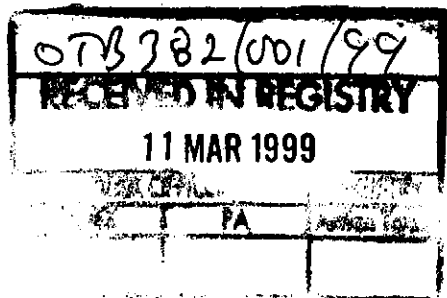
Re: Complaint from Mr Philip Swift - Oppressive conduct

Your fax of 2 March 1999 together with correspondence from the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, with a copy of Philip Swift's letter, refers.

I have written to the Acting Attorney-General requesting legal advice in regard to the information being disseminated by Swift on the Internet. The information is misleading and damaging to Bermuda. His concerns were fully investigated by the Police Service. He is a disgruntled former Bermuda Police officer who feels his contract should have been renewed.

I suggest we await the advice of the Acting Attorney-General before responding. Some caution is necessary when accessing Mr Swift's web site, as he has inserted a virus in his document.

I believe your predecessor, [REDACTED] was provided with background information on Mr Swift, and a copy of his early releases.
